In particular it is only with experience the paediatric surgeon can know what to do when patients insist on not following the course prescribed by the erudite descriptions in the text!

An important point to remember that books are always out of date; the pace of change is so rapid that by the time the book has come to publication things may have already moved on. Nowhere is this more relevant than paediatric surgery.
